
1. Purpose. To announce the Pensacola Naval Complex-wide blood drives for 2004.
2. Background. All civil service and nonappropriated fund employees (excluding contract employees) become members of the Civilian Blood Donor Club when employed. Benefits are as outlined in reference (a).
3. Responsibility. In accordance with reference (b), the U. S. Naval Hospital Pensacola has responsibility for the oversight of all collection on local military installations. It is a community responsibility of those members capable of donating blood to ensure that there is always a sufficient supply available for those who have a need.
4. Procedures. The Bloodmobile will visit selected areas throughout the Pensacola Naval Complex on a prearranged schedule. All employees in the general area of the Bloodmobile are encouraged to donate blood. Supervisors are requested to encourage donations to the maximum extent possible. Employees who serve as blood donors are entitled to be excused from work without charge to leave for time necessary to donate and for recuperation following blood donation. Maximum excused time (administrative leave) will not exceed 4 hours and must be requested and documented on Request for Leave or Approved Absence Form, OPM Form 7 1. Those employees unable to donate after visiting the Bloodmobile will be required to return to work.
 - a. Enclosure (1) is provided for the general information of all and indicates donor acceptability qualifications.

b. Enclosure (2) lists the schedule for 2004 and indicates the location of the Bloodmobile within each drive area (NAS Pensacola, Saufley and Whiting Field). Appointments are required to donate blood and may be obtained by telephoning the Northwest Florida Blood Center, Inc. at (850) 434-2535. Employees unable to keep their scheduled blood donation appointment should call the aforementioned telephone number to cancel as soon as possible. Employees should not arrive at the Bloodmobile earlier than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled appointments.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice remains in effect until superseded.

**DONOR ACCEPTABILITY
ADDENDUM**

QUALIFICATIONS:

- * Minimum weight to be 110 pounds.
- * Be in good health on date of donation.
- * Must be at least 17 years of age.
- * Two month (56 days) interval from date of last blood donation.

RECENT ILLNESS:

- * Defer for 72 hours (if no fever) after having stomach virus (24-hour type).
- * Defer for 72 hours after any recent infection, fever, boils, or sore throat. Also fever blister or mouth ulcer from onset of first symptom and evidence of healing must be present.

HEPATITIS:

- * This is considered a permanent rejection.
- * Testing positive is also cause for permanent rejection.
- * Defer for 12 months if contact was made with a Hepatitis patient through shared:
 1. Smoking, eating, or drinking (from utensils used by them) or,
 2. Kissing and all other intimate contact.
 3. Living in same household

TRANSFUSIONS, TATTOOS, BODY PIERCING OR ANY BLOOD COMPONENT:

- * Defer for 12 months

MALARIA, USE OF ANTI-MALARIA DRUGS OR HAVING BEEN OVERSEAS IN A MALARIAL AREA:

- * Defer for 3 years the following:
 1. Having had malaria, must be asymptomatic for 3 years.
 2. Any donor who has been in a malarial area 12 months.
 3. Immigrants or foreign visitors from an endemic area.
- * Defer for 12 months the following:

Donor who has traveled in a malarial area and returned to a nonendemic area and is free of all symptoms of malaria for 12 months.

HEART PROBLEM:

- * Blood Center personnel need a note from the physician and the donor must be restriction/medication free from heart problems. Some exceptions without a note.

LUNG DISEASE:

- * Active disease is rejection but chronic condition or asymptomatic may donate.

TUBERCULOSIS:

- * Negative chest x-ray. No longer taking INH.

BLEEDING PROBLEMS:

- * Rejection.

CONVULSIONS:

- * Rejection.

HARD DRUGS:

- * Permanent deferral if use is mainlined (injected) using a needle.

MARIJUANA:

- * Must not be under the influence of marijuana at the time of donation.

ALCOHOL:

- * Excessive alcohol use in past 12 hours or intoxication is cause for rejection.

KIDNEY/LIVER DISEASE:

- * To be evaluated by blood-drawing staff.

CANCER:

- * Must be symptom free 5 years after removal for most cancers. Leukemia, lymphoma, and Hodgkin's are permanent deferrals.

SKIN CANCER:

- * May donate after removal and healing and release by treating' physician.

VACCINATIONS/INOCULATIONS:

- * Defer for 2 weeks:
Yellow fever, mumps, rubella, oral polio, oral typhoid, Japanese encephalitis

- * Defer for 4 weeks:

German measles, gamma globulin, chicken pox, MMR, rubella

- * Defer for 1 year:

Hepatitis Immune Globulin; any unlicensed vaccine. Rabies if given for animal bite.

VENEREAL DISEASE:

- Defer for 12 months:

Had syphilis or gonorrhea or was treated for same in last 12 months.

CURRENTLY UNDER PHYSICIAN'S CARE:

- * Unacceptable:

Anticoagulants (blood thinners), cancer drugs, must have name of medication currently taking.

- * Defer for 48 hours:

Antibiotics for infections. May give if taking antibiotics for skin.

- * Defer for 30 days:

Accutane, Proscar, Propecia

CORTICOSTEROIDS:

- * Condition needs to be assessed by collection staff.

ANTIDEPRESSANTS/TRANQUILIZERS:

- * If condition is stable.

SURGERY:

- *Exceptions:

Hernia or appendectomy will be accepted after healing is completed.

- * Minor Surgery:

Will be accepted after healing is completed and released by physician.

- * Major Surgery:

Treated, healed, released. Resumed normal activity

PREGNANCY:

- * Not currently pregnant nor have delivered, aborted or miscarried in the last 6 weeks.

BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICATION:

- * May donate if blood pressure is stabilized and medication is for blood pressure only.

TRAVEL

* Personnel who have traveled to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom must wait 12 months from date of return to CONUS.

ANY CONTACT WITH KNOWN AIDS VICTIM OR CARRIER WILL BE CAUSE FOR REJECTION UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

ACCEPTABLE DRUGS

- * Allergy shots
- * Analgesics (pain medications such as aspirin)
- * Anorexics (diet pills)
- * Antibiotics (last dose 48 hours – symptom free for 72 hours)
- * Antidepressants
- * Antacids
- * Antihistamines
- * Antihypertensive agents
- * Antispasmodics
- * Birth control pills
- * Corticosteroids
- * Diuretics
- * Eye medication
- * Fertility agents (if not pregnant)
- * Gout medication (must be symptom free)
- * Hormones
- * Muscle relaxants
- * Sedatives
- * Thyroid
- * Tranquilizers
- * Vitamins
