Subj: MIKE MANSFIELD FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM 2004

The Maureen and Mike Mansfield Foundation is recruiting candidates for the Maureen and Mike Mansfield Fellowship Program, informational sessions beginning in October 2003.

This fellowship program was established by the U.S. Congress in 1994 to build a cadre of federal employees who, because they have lived in Japan and worked long-term on projects in Japanese ministries, can be an asset to their U.S. agencies on Japan-related policies and programs. Participants are either funded by their own agency or by the program.

The intensive, 2-year program is composed of 1 year in Japan working full-time in professional positions in Japanese government offices, preceded by a year of in-depth study in the United States of the Japanese language and area studies. In previous years, Mansfield Fellows have been placed in the Ministries of Finance, Education, Foreign Affairs, International Trade and Industry, Health and Welfare, the Environment Agency, National Police Agency and the Japan External Trade Organization.
